Call to Worship

his praise will always be on my lips.
I will glory in the LORD;
let the afflicted hear and rejoice.

let us exalt his name together.**

Confession

Father in heaven,
wholeness, healing and flourishing
come from what you have done.
Through Jesus' life, death and resurrection,
you have reconciled us with you.

We come to you this morning forsaking
our own efforts to earn your acceptance.
We now turn away from them
and rest in what you have done
instead of trying to build a foundation on what we have done.

Words of Forgiveness

He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life. Communion Litany

Minister: The Lord be with you.

People: And also with you.

Minister: As we come to the table,
let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All: With joy we praise you, gracious God,
for you have created heaven and earth,
made us in your image,
and kept covenant with us—
even when we fell into sin.
We give you thanks for Jesus Christ,
our Lord, who came among us
as the Word made flesh
to show us your glory,
full of grace and truth.
Therefore we join our voices
with all the saints and angels
and the whole creation
to proclaim the glory of your name.

Minister: As our Savior taught us, so we pray,

All: Our Father in heaven,
hallowed be your name.
Your kingdom come, your will be done,
on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us today our daily bread.
Forgive us our sins as we forgive
those who sin against us.
Lead us not into temptation
but deliver us from evil.

For yours is the kingdom, the power,
and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.

Minister: Therefore we proclaim the mystery
of the faith:

All: Christ has died. Christ is risen.
Christ will come again.

Minister: Christ, our Passover, is sacrificed for us.

All: Therefore, let us keep the feast.

All: Thanks be to God.

Minister: Let us give thanks to God.

All: Most gracious God, we praise you
for what you have given and
for what you have promised us here.
You have made us one with all your people
in heaven and on earth.
You have fed us with the bread of life,
and renewed us for your service.
Now we give ourselves to you;
and we ask that our daily living may be
part of your kingdom,
and that our love may be your love,
reaching out into the life of the world;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
