## Confession

We confess that we remain captivated by  
the things of this world that promise so much, but deliver so little.  
We live as if we were our own gods.

We do not believe that you could be calling us  
to something more noble and beautiful than our own self rule.  
So we settle for lives of rebellion against your reign over us.

We quickly forget that your grace is infinite  
and that your rule over us is one of love and compassion.  
We forget that you are not just King but Father as well.

We forget that Jesus came, not to call the righteous, but the unrighteous.  
Forgive us, King of mercy. Invade our lives by your Spirit and make us new.  
Grant that we may know the joy of abundant life given in Jesus Christ,  
the promised king.

## Words of Forgiveness

**14** Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven,[f] Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. **15** For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. **16** Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need. (Hebrews 4:14-16)

the communion of saints,

the resurrection of the body,  
and the life everlasting. Amen.**

Minister: The Lord be with you.

**All: And also with you.**

Minister: Lift up your hearts!

**All: We lift them up to the Lord!**

Minister: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

**All: It is right to give him thanks and  
praise, joining our voices with your  
people on earth and all the company  
of heaven, who forever sing  
to the glory of your Name.**

Minister: Therefore we proclaim the mystery of the faith:

**All: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.**

Minister: Christ, our Passover, is sacrificed for us.

**All: Therefore, let us keep the feast.**

**All: Holy God, we see your glory**
